



# RELEASE REPORT

Proposition 66 removes several crimes from the “serious felony” strike list. Because it’s retroactive to 1994, thousands of inmates with long histories of serious and violent crime will have their sentences dramatically reduced and be back on the street. Here’s just one example.

**Name:** Robert Boyce

**Criminal history:** Five prior convictions for rape. Within weeks of his release from prison, beat a woman he was living with beyond recognition after she asked him to leave because of his crack cocaine use. When arrested, was in possession of a firearm. Now serving a sentence of 25 years to life.

**Proposition 66 release date:** Under Proposition 66, Mr. Boyce’s sentence would be reduced to a maximum of seven years, eight months. Because of time served and “good time” credits, he would be eligible for immediate release.
